

Rear Cable - Handbrake - Replace (12 675 0)




1. Slacken the wheel nuts, raise the vehicle and remove the rear road wheels.



- 2. De-adjust the handbrake cable.
 - 1 Remove the locking pin.
 - 2 Slacken the adjuster locknut.
 - 3 Slacken the adjuster until the levers on the calipers have returned to their stops.




3. Disconnect the handbrake cable from the equaliser yoke.







- 1 Pull back the caliper levers.
- 2 Unhook the handbrake cables from the caliper levers.
- 3 Remove the handbrake cable retaining clips.
- 4 Detach the handbrake cables from the calipers.



5. Detach the handbrake cable from the lower arms.



- 6. Remove the handbrake cable from the body fixings.
 - 1 Remove the circlip securing the non adjuster side of the cable.
 - 2 Remove the non adjuster side of the cable.
 - 3 Remove the adjuster side of the cable.



7. Pull the cables through the rear axle and remove the cables.

8. Relocate the cable.

Ensure that the cable is routed correctly.

- 9. Refit the cable to the body fixings.
- 10. Reconnect the handbrake cable to the caliper assembly.
- 11. Reconnect the handbrake cable to the equaliser yoke.
- 12. Adjust the handbrake as described in Operation No. 12 662 0.
- 13. Refit the road wheels and lower the vehicle.
